

K.C.Y.S.A. PLAYER & SPECTATOR CODE OF ETHICS

All players must agree and adhere to the following code of ethics and the penalties given. All offenses are reviewed on a case by case basis and final penalty is subject to change based on board's recommendation.

1. Abusive language to officials, players, coaches, or spectators – **EJECTION**
2. Foul or abusive language to officials, players, or spectators – **CAUTION/EJECTION/SEASON SUSPENSION**
3. Threatening actions or words toward officials, players, or spectators – **EJECTION**
4. Aggressive physical contact with the referee – **EJECTION AND 4 GAME SUSPENSION**
5. Aggressive physical contact with players – **EJECTION – 2ND OFFENSE, 1 GAME SUSPENSION**
6. Striking an official – **EJECTION AND SEASON SUSPENSION**
7. Striking or kicking a player – **EJECTION – 2ND OFFENSE, SEASON SUSPENSION**
8. Refusal to leave the playing field after an ejection – **1 GAME SUSPENSION**
9. Any player observed using or under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol before or during a game – **EJECTION WITH 1 GAME SUSPENSION UP TO EXPULSION**

The listed offenses are not all inclusive and any actions detrimental to the program will be punished as deemed appropriate by the Soccer Board.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: All registered players in our soccer program are required to explain to everyone attending their games the following:

It shall be against the rules of SAY soccer for a spectator, coach, or player to threaten, harass or intimidate soccer officials in any way. This includes before, during, and after the games. Failure to comply with the above rules could mean expulsion from the game and field area and/or loss of the game by judgment of the area review board of this soccer association. Any physical contact with a soccer official could result in legal action by the soccer association.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. All ejections will be reported to the games commissioner.
2. Penalties that are longer than the remaining season will be carried over to next season.
3. Penalties that are assessed after a game will be carried over to the next game.
